SUBJECT: Draft Request for Proposal (RFP) NNM09263608R for the *NASA Information Technology Services (NICS)* Acquisition at the NASA George C. Marshall Space Flight Center (MSFC)

The Draft RFP for the *NASA Information Technology Services (NICS)* acquisition at NASA MSFC has been released. All offerors should review the Draft RFP and submit comments by the date and time specified on the I³P website.

The proposed procurement is to be evaluated by a Source Evaluation Board in accordance with procedures prescribed by the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) and the NASA FAR Supplement (NFS). This Draft RFP is not a solicitation, but is issued as an acquisition planning instrument and as a means of soliciting industry comments for use in developing the future formal solicitation.

A site tour for MSFC is anticipated on or about May 14, 2009. Additional site tours of other NASA Centers are also anticipated. The schedule for these visits and additional information and instructions regarding site tours will be posted on the I³P website at: <http://i3p.nasa.gov>.

The Draft RFP is comprised of a contract sections A through I, Attachments J-1 through J-22, Attachment A (Sections K, L, and M), Attachment B (Cost Forms), and Attachment C (Background and Historical Information). As part of the NAIS Draft RFP posting, the following documents/information is not yet available, but will be posted as soon as available:

1. Center Procurement Office Points of Contact for Center-documentation not posted on the I³P site (Provision L.18)
2. Attachment C (Background and Historical Information)
3. Center Zone Architecture Project (CZAP) details in Attachment J-1 (App. D-2)

Potential offerors are invited to submit comments and questions on all aspects of the Draft RFP, including the requirements, schedules, proposal preparation instructions and evaluation factors. These comments and questions shall be submitted in accordance with the instructions provided on the I³P website. Responses to questions will also be provided on this site. All comments will be considered, but it is not the Government's intent to post responses.
