UR1 Technical Approach to Meeting the Requirements of the SOW

The Offeror shall provide a narrative response that demonstrates its understanding of the overall technical requirements expressed in the SOW. The Offeror's response shall contain information specific to each of the major performance areas in the SOW (3.1 Operational Safety; 3.2 Occupational Health; 3.3 Energy and Environment to the third level of requirements (i.e x.x.x). **The Offeror's response for Section 4.0 Aeronautics and Space Flight and Ground System Mission Assurance) shall contain information to the second level of requirements (i.e. x.x).** The response shall include:

- a. Approaches to meeting the technical requirements pertaining to the SOW.
- b. Any approaches for improving the products, outcomes, or deliverables required under the SOW.

MP 6 Organizational Conflict of Interest (OCI) Avoidance Plan

In accordance with NFS 1837.203-70, "Providing contractors access to sensitive information (<http://www.hq.nasa.gov/office/procurement/regs/1837.htm>)," Offerors shall provide a preliminary analysis of possible organizational conflicts of interest that might flow from the award of this contract and how any organizational conflict of interest identified might be mitigated. Offerors shall submit a comprehensive Organizational Conflicts of Interest Avoidance Plan. This comprehensive plan shall incorporate any previous studies performed, shall thoroughly analyze all organizational conflicts of interest that might arise because the Contractor has access to other companies' sensitive information, and shall establish specific methods to control, mitigate, or eliminate all problems identified. This plan shall also address specific methods of mitigation to address the OCI identified **as follows:**

- Under the SHEMA contract, the Prime Contractor/Subcontractors may be responsible for assisting in the preparation of specifications or work statements and providing evaluation and oversight services. These services might cause an organizational conflict of interest as outlined in FAR 9.505-2 and 9.505-3 respectively.

- Under the SHEMA contract, the Prime Contractor/Subcontractors may be granted access to proprietary competitor information. Access to this information might cause an organizational conflict of interest as outlined in FAR 9.505-4.

Consideration will be given to the adequacy, realism, effectiveness, and completeness of the plan.
