Will a layered Adobe Photoshop file in PSD format be an acceptable substitute to the “raw” format specified?</p> <p>b) For an example of “high speed imagery” is an AVI video file acceptable as the “raw” format? Is a still of the first frame saved as a jpeg acceptable as the “jpeg” format?</p>	<p>a) Yes. A PSD format will work for an example of a “manipulation of an image.”</p> <p>B) An AVI file or a DVD will work to show a example of high speed imagery, no need to make a jpeg of the first frame.</p>
	<p>2. The draft RFP included a labor escalation rate of 2.5% that was to be applied each year in order to develop pricing based on a consistent estimating assumption that all bidders were to follow. We note that this approach appears to be absent in the final RFP. Does the Government plan to apply this same technique and amount for response pricing purposes?</p>	<p>An escalation factor will not be provided.
