SF 33, Page 1	1. Is there a specific due date for submitting all questions on the AEMMS Solicitation package? I just could not find such information in the RFP.	Questions on the AEMMS final solicitation need to be received in a sufficient time-frame, prior to the proposal due date so the Government may have time to respond.
SF 33, Page 1	2. Block 9 of SF33 and RFP Section L.4 (b) - Proposal Mailing Address? Block 9 points to Section L.4 (b) that points back to Block 9. Block 9 contains only Building and Room # information! Would the address information contained in Block 7 combined with Bldg./Room # information in Block 9 provide a correct mailing address for submitting proposals by US Mail or FedEx?	The address information contained in Block 7 combined with Bldg./Room # information in Block 9 provide a correct mailing address for submitting proposals by US Mail or FedEx.
Section L.7 (b), Pages 68 & 70	3. I would like to request further clarification on the intent of NASA's request for relevant contracts in excess of \$1,000,000 total contract value, received in the past three (3) years. Can a contractor submit contracts that have ended recently, but were awarded more than three years ago?	Section L.7 (b) <u>Past Performance Proposal (Volume II)</u> , Paragraph (1), Page 68, shall be amended to read: “A list of not more than six relevant contracts (government and/or industry contracts), each in excess of \$1,000,000 total contract value, received or performed in the past three (3) years, or currently on-going, involving types of related effort. ...”

Section B.3, Page 6	4. Will the Government fill in all the TBDs in this section?	Upon award of the contract the Government will fill in all the TBDs in this section with the correct funding numbers.
Section F.5, Page 14	5. Is it OK to infer that "other locations as directed by the Ames Research Center Contracting Officer." implies Government owned facility and not off-site at contractor's facilities?	"Other locations as directed by the Ames Research Center Contracting Officer" means exactly what it states "other locations as directed by the Ames Research Center Contracting Officer". This could mean off-site facilities or on-site facilities.
Section G.3 (c) (1), Page 16	6. Should this insert (NASA or DCAA mailing office address) be provided by the contractor?	The NASA or DCAA office mailing address must be provided by the awardee.
Section G.3, "SPECIAL INVOICING INSTRUCTIONS FOR RECOVERY ACT FUNDS" Page 17	7. Will the government always issue all recovery funded work under separate work orders? Is it OK to assume that non-recovery and recovery funded work items will not be combined in a single work orders?	The Government will always issue Recovery funded work under a separate work/task order. Recovery and Non-Recovery work will not be combined in the same work/task order.
Section L.4 (c), Page 60	8. "No cost/price data shall be included except for a schedule of wages, salaries and benefits." Does this statement allow the inclusion of wages, salaries, and benefits information in dollars for named employees and/or proposed labor categories in the technical proposal?	The contractor should follow the instructions in Section L (example: salary ranges and fringe benefits proposed for employees ... are requested under the Management Approach Element: Total Compensation Plan).

What is the required delivery time for this document?	The Organizational Conflict of Interest Avoidance Plan is included in the solicitation and resulting contract. An Organizational Conflicts of Interest Avoidance Plan shall be provided in the proposal that is due no later than January 13, 2009, Noon PST. The date and no. of pages will be completed at time of award or by subsequent modification.
Section J.1, Page 51 Section L.7 (a) C, Page 67	10. Section J.1 notes that the Safety and Health Plan is to be completed at the time of the award while Section L.7 (a) C seems to require it with the submittal of the proposal. What is the required delivery time for this document?	The Safety and Health Plan is included in the solicitation and resulting contract. Section L.7 (a) C: The Offeror shall submit a detailed written safety and health plan as stated in the RFP. Section J.1: The date and no. of pages will be completed at time of award or by subsequent modification.

We are unable to provide cost plus pricing breakdown referenced in your Government Pricing Model Exhibit. Is this acceptable for this opportunity?</p>	<p>Due to the requirements the Government intends to award a Cost Plus Fixed Fee contract. Therefore, offerors are requested to follow the instructions provided in Section L of the solicitation.</p>
<p>AEMMS Statement of Work</p>	<p>12. What has been the distribution of the modeling and simulation support workload among the various "Requesting Organizations" during the past couple of years?
