

Questions regarding Solicitation Number: NNC09ZF031Q, Recovery Act – Icing Research Tunnel Refrigeration Systems Upgrade – Design Build

Q1. My company participated in the concept study referenced in Attachment 2 of the solicitation. While the final report of this study is published and available to all prospective bidders, will the rest of the information developed in the study effort also be published to all bidders? This information would include all calculations, memos, meeting minutes, sketches, drawings, detailed cost estimate back up information, equipment vendor discussions, quantity take offs, etc.

A1. No. The most substantive information from the 2007 Concept Study is contained in the report made available to all offerors. The Study Team included all findings and back-up information in the Concept Study Report.

Q2. In Phase II will the government specify the desired solution for the upgrade, e.g. Option 1, 2, or 3; new building or renovated building; heat exchanger changes; other ideas generated from the Phase I Qualifications submittals, etc.

A2. The requirements of Phase II will be fully addressed in the Phase II solicitation

Q3. We understand that we have to utilize the Attachment A for listing relevant experience. In what format do you require the rest of the RFQ ?

A3. There is no specific format as long as all elements are addressed

Q4. The entire proposal including team organization, resumes, technical approach, up to 5 relevant projects (attachment A format) must not exceed 25 pages?

A4. The past performance questionnaires and the relevant project experience submittals are **not** to be included in the 25 page count

Q5. Can we get a copy of the previous information submitted for the Sources Sought (NNC092F0297) due on September 2? We submitted as a potential A/E subcontractor and are looking for a list of other firms that submitted.
