42	L	L.32		Section L.32 (k) states, "The minimum requirement for hypertext links is an overall proposal table of contents linked to each volume and a table of contents within each PDF file linked to each section of the file." Based on this statement, are we to assume that all volumes of the proposal are to be submitted on 1 CD-ROM? If this is the case, we request that Volume V, Cost, be allowed to be submitted on a separate CD as the cost volume information will require more than 1 CD.	In accordance with L-32 (b), either a CD or DVD is acceptable. Furthermore, the instructions in Section L of the RFP do not preclude the submission of the the Cost Volume on its own CD/DVD. Therefore, the submission of the Cost Volume on a separate CD/DVD is acceptable.
