**Question 1:**

Should you be using the exception for Space Vehicles, with a size standard of 1,000?

**Answer 1:**

The basic size standard of 500 employees under NAICS Code 541712 for Research and Development in the Physical, Engineering, and Life Sciences was chosen incorrectly. Of the three exceptions for NAICS Code 541712, the exceptions for space vehicles and guided missiles, their propulsion units parts, and their auxiliary equipment and parts is more applicable to this procurement. A modification to the Pre-Solicitation Synopsis has been published to correct the size standard for this procurement to 1,000 employees. The NAICS Code 541712 remains unchanged.

**Question 2:**

Sol. # NNJ10336472R "Test Evaluation and Support Team – Test:" Description calls out a "partial follow-on to the TEC" and has a Period of Performance (POP) and Sol Type for Full & Open.

Sol. #NNJ09ZBH001L "Test and Evaluation Services and Facility Operations and Support Services does not define a POP, a Sol Type, Draft RFP date, Pre-proposal Conference not a Final RFP. There is also a difference between the two Sol(s) in NAICS Size.

Q: Please clarify the difference in these (2) Solicitations and their objectives, i.e., how do they integrate together or do they?

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**Answer 2:**

The NNJ09ZBH001L reference number was used in the early stages of acquisition strategy development and is no longer applicable to the TEST solicitation. For information related to TEST, NNJ10336472R is the appropriate reference number.
