

## **AMENDMENT 01 to REQUEST FOR INFORMATION NNK11OE08R**

The National Aeronautics and Space Administration's (NASA) Kennedy Space Center (KSC) has posted the draft Statement of Work (SOW) for the Safety And Mission Assurance Support Services II (S-MASS II) acquisition. This action is to encourage and promote early exchanges of information for this requirement as a part of NASA's acquisition streamlining initiatives. Industry comments pertaining to the draft SOW shall be submitted to the Contracting Officer via email at [erik.c.whitehill@nasa.gov](mailto:erik.c.whitehill@nasa.gov). The due date for Government receipt of industry comments pertaining to the draft SOW shall be no later than June 17, 2011.

The Government will hold one-on-one meetings the week of June 13, 2011. The Government's purpose in holding the one-on-one meetings is to discuss industry comments relating to the draft SOW (reasonableness of requirements) and any other concern industry may have with the overall procurement. The exchanges held during one-on-one sessions will not be recorded nor published subsequently. The one-on-one meetings will be limited to six per day at a length not to exceed 45 minutes and scheduled on a first-come, first-served basis.

Advance submission of comments by interested parties is encouraged before the one-on-one meetings. Request for one-on-one meetings should be submitted no later than 4:00 p.m. EDT Thursday, June 9, 2011.
