The RFP does not commit the Government to award a contract nor does it obligate the Government to pay for any cost incurred in the preparation and submittal of

proposals or in anticipation of a contract. The Government reserves the right to reject any and all proposals should such action be in the best interest of the Government.

Offerors are hereby notified that funds are not presently available for this effort. The Government's obligation is contingent upon the availability of appropriated funds from which payment for contract purposes can be made. It is anticipated that adequate funds, for the contract minimum, will be available at the time of contract award.

On or before July 15, 2011, written questions may be submitted by potential Offerors to the Government for review and written response. Questions received after that date will be considered, but may not be answered. Since answers and associated questions are provided to all Offerors eligible for award, questions should not include any proprietary or sensitive information that the questioner does not wish to be disclosed to other Offerors.
