1.	Section L.12	Section L.12 lists the Delivery Address which proposals should be addressed and delivered to; however, it also states that proposals must be delivered "through NASA JSC Central Receiving," and then the Central Receiving address is provided. This is a bit confusing. Do we need to include the Central Receiving address on the packaging so that the courier knows to deliver the package to Central Receiving? Please clarify.	Yes, all proposals delivered by U.S. Postal Service, Commercial Delivery Service, or by company employee or other individual agent must include the JSC Central Receiving Office address and the delivery address as specified in Section L.12(c). Proposals are received through the JSC Central Receiving Office for security screening. Therefore, Offerors are encouraged to plan accordingly when delivering their proposals to ensure proposals are received by the designated time stated in Section L.12.
2.	Section L.17.4(4) and Attachment L-2 Past Performance Questionnaire	Several of our customers who are providing past performance references are concerned about their responses being delivered by January 17 using standard mail service. Will the government consider allowing past performance questionnaires to be submitted via fax or e-mail? If so, will you provide the official fax number and e-mail address?	No, all Past Performance Questionnaires are to be returned directly to the Contract Specialist in a sealed envelope to the address identified in Attachment L-2 Past Performance Questionnaire. Proposal Volume II, Past Performance is requested early, but is not officially due until 2/6/2012.
3.	Section L.17.5	Due to the time constraints of providing the Past Performance volume early, we respectfully request that this question be answered quickly. Please confirm that the Safety Data requested for each worksite in the Past Performance Volume applies only to the five contracts performed in the last three years that we have provided as references and not every single contract we have performed work on in the past three years.	The Safety Past Performance requirement is for all contracts performed during the past 3 years. To accommodate this requirement the OSHA 300 and 300A reports page limitation are unlimited.
4.	Section L.7 (c)	Section L.7 (c) states "Title pages, tables of contents, and	Transmittal letters are not required to be submitted with each volume. If an Offeror
