Section L.5(b)(2), page 61 and Section B.2, page 2</p>	<p>The sixth bullet in Section L.5(b)(2) states, in part: "A completed response to Section B, Clause B.2, "Supplies/Services to be Provided"...."</p> <p>"Supplies/Services to be Provided" is the title for Clause B.1. The title for Clause B.2 is "Estimated Cost and Fixed Fee (1852.216-74) (DEC 1991)."</p> <p>Please confirm that Section L.5(b)(2) should reference "Estimated Cost and Fixed Fee (1852.216-74) (DEC 1991)" instead of "Supplies/Services to be Provided."</p>	<p>The Final Request for Proposal will be amended to correct title to clause 1852.216-74, see Amendment Two (2).</p>
<p>2. Section J.1(b)2, Page 50</p>	<p>Can the Government please provide a MS Word Version of the Proposal Cover Sheet (JA 038) – Exhibit 1?</p>	<p>A word version of Proposal Cover Sheet (JA 038) will be posted.</p>
<p>3. Section J.1(a)2, Page 50</p>	<p>Attachment J.1(a)2 to the subject solicitation is the Wage Determination (WD) for Alameda and Contra Costa counties. The WD included in the Draft RFP was for Santa Clara and Santa Cruz counties. Please clarify.</p>	<p>A revised Wage Determination (WD) will be revised to Santa Clara and Santa Cruz counties see Amendment Two (2).</p>
<p>4. Section I, Page 31</p>	<p>The solicitation includes 52.204-4 (Printed or Copied Double-Sided on Postconsumer Fiber Content Paper) in Section I. Does this clause also apply to the proposal submission due on 1/10/13? The printed Excel Costing Model will be much easier to read if it is printed single-sided instead of double-sided. Please advise.</p>	<p>For proposal submission, a single-sided will be acceptable for the Excel costing model.</p>
