## **Attachment A.3 – Specific Training**

### **Firearms Training**

The Contractor shall conduct firearms range operations to maintain the required qualification and proficiency of the workforce, and support of other training requirements per the NASA Firearms Qualifications Course listed in NPR 1600.1. This shall be accomplished within thirty (30) calendar days of appointment to position. No Security Police Officer will be armed without successfully completing this course.

The Contractor shall ensure the safety of range operations and shall conduct lead monitoring and other operational or safety reviews.

The Contractor shall ensure the safety, serviceability and proper maintenance of all firearms, ammunition and related equipment utilized to meet the requirements of the contract.

Firearms maintenance shall be conducted by a qualified armorer.

### **External Training**

External training is that training which the Contractor may be tasked to perform by the CO for personnel who are not protective services Contractor employees or subcontractors. Example of training which apply to most facilities is listed below.

The Contractor shall also conduct external training for personnel at all facilities where required by NPR's, by law or under each locations' specific requirements.

Required Security Education, Briefings and Orientations:

- a. The Contractor shall provide security education, annual and periodic security briefings to both internal and external personnel (i.e. classification management training, SBU training, annual or periodic security briefings for those with access to various categories of classified information or Special Access Programs, annual workplace violence training).
- b. The Contractor shall provide security education support or administration, briefing and training media for external programs they administer.
- c. The Contractor shall conduct crime prevention training for the general GSFC population. Training may include, but is not limited to, such topics as: locking offices and security containers, use and control of keys, security systems, and general loss prevention topics.

## **Emergency Management Training**

The Contractor shall participate in or conduct emergency management training for the general population as required by NPR 8715.2, the National Incident Management System (NIMS) and other requirements identified by the COR.

The Contractor shall conduct or support comprehensive drills, tests and exercises. The Contractor shall support efforts associated with the GSFC Continuity of Operations Plan (COOP) to include significant support of COOP drills and exercises.
