Please clarify if the Contractor will be expected to conduct Human Subjects Research (HSR). If so, will the Contractor serve as Co-Principal Investigator, Co-Investigator, Associate Investigator, or in another role?</p> <p>b. If Contractor will be conducting HSR, is it expected that the Contractor will operate under NASA's Federal Wide Assurance (FWA) and Institutional Review Board (IRB), or under Contractor's own FWA and/or IRB?</p> <p>c. If HSR is anticipated, what is the nature of the research that the Contractor would be expected to undertake?</p> <p>d. Would the Contractor be exposed to Protected Health Information (PHI) or Identifiable Private Information in this role, and if so, what would be the nature of such exposure?</p> <p>e. If HSR is not required under this task order, is it anticipated that the Contractor will conduct HSR at some point during the life of the contract under other tasks, and would the Contractor be required at that time to conduct the research using its own FWA and/or IRB?</p>	<p>a.
