Can you please confirm?	Yes, this is correct. Per L.9(b)(1)p.89 of the RFP: "A list of not more than four (4) relevant contracts (government and/or industry contracts), each in excess of \$10,000,000 total contract value for the prime and each in excess of \$3,000,000 total contract value for the major subcontractor, completed in the past three (3) years, or currently on-going, involving types of related effort."
	38. We would like to use one of our team members past performance for which they were a subcontractor to a competitor of ours. The government client has agreed to complete the past performance for us but I need to ensure this is acceptable.	Yes, this is acceptable. Per L.9(b)(1)p. 89 of the RFP: "Industry contracts involving subcontracting to another company that may have a prime contract with some area of the government may be included."
