



VALUES \$3,001 - \$100,000
RECOMMENDATION AND DETERMINATION TO SOLICIT FROM ONE
SOURCE – PR 4200439738

NASA, John F. Kennedy Space Center, will negotiate only with Data Center Resources. The total estimated cost of this effort is [REDACTED] and the estimated period of performance or lead-time for delivery is 90 days.

Pursuant to FAR 13.106-1(b) and 13.106-3(b)(3)(i), the acquisition of referenced Console Furniture are determined to be available from only one source. Competition is impractical for the following reasons:

1. The Government intends to purchase furniture from the Data Center Resources to supplement existing furniture to meet the existing facilities form, fit and function.
2. Furniture must be the same as existing furniture which allows us to reconfigure facility settings interchangeably to accommodate office requirements.
3. The existing furniture has been vetted by Kennedy Space Center in the telemetry area. Sensitivity of the existing equipment requires that Data Center Resources install the furniture, to meet the existing layout specification and to mitigate potential damage of existing furniture.
4. Pursuant to FAR 5.201, NFS 1805.207, and 1804.570, any contract action over \$25,000 (not bought via GSA or SEWP) shall be synopsisized in the Government wide Point of Entry (GPE) and published on the NASA Acquisition Internet Service (NAIS) by the Contracting Officer for a period of 15 days. In addition, the brand name justification must be referenced or attached.
