Section L, L.10(a)(B)</p>	<p>Concerning Section L, Page L-8, paragraph 2: Fifteen (15) days prior to the proposal due date, each offeror shall provide the NASA Ames Research Center Contracting Officer with a list of contracts from whom the offeror has past performance information and send that list via email to patricia.f.mendoza@nasa.gov.</p> <p>Please confirm that 15 days prior to proposal due date is 15 calendar days before proposal due date (Monday, May 27, 2013).</p>	<p>Amendment 2 will change Section L, page L-8, from 15 days to 12 days. New Date will be May 29, 2013.</p>
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10. Section L, L.10(a)(B)	Is the request of a list of contracts from whom the offeror has past performance information meant to be a list of all relevant projects where the offeror has CCASS/CPAR evaluations? If so, would it be helpful for the offeror to also send the CCASS/CPAR evaluations as well? Alternatively, should this list only include a list of the 3 contracts from RFP Section L.10 (a)?	The CCASS/CPAR evaluations are checked by the Government not sent by the offeror. The offeror is to follow Section L, L.10(a) Proposal Preparation-Specific Instructions which states, "The offeror shall each submit relevant past performance for up to three (3) projects (over \$1,000,000) which were similar in size, content and complexity of the requirements set forth in Section C, and that were completed within the last three (3) years."
11. Section L, L.10(a)(A)	Would NASA consider revising Section L.10 (a) A. to allow use of projects completed in the last 5 years?	The government has considered your request and the three (3) year requirement shall remain the same.
12. Section L, L.10(a)(A)	Would NASA consider allowing projects at least 50% complete to be included?	The Government has considered your request and Section L, L.10(a)(A) will remain the same.
13. Section L, L.10(a)(B)	The PPQ's and questions are due on May 27, 2012 which happens to be a federal holiday. Will you extend this date to May 28, 2013?	See Amendment 2 for the extension of the Past Performance Questionnaires and any questions. The date they are due is extended by two (2) days, May 29, 2013.

Section L, L.10(a)	Our team partners qualifications are an important piece of our overall qualifications and we would like to request that we be allowed to submit their past performance projects and the associated PPQ's as a part of our past performance qualifications. Will this be acceptable?	Per Section L, L.10(a), "The goal of this factor is to obtain information regarding relevant past performance of the offeror specifically in the areas of management, administration, and other information. If the offeror does not have enough references to meet these requirements, references shall be provided to the maximum extent possible." We are requesting the past performance for the offeror.
15. Sections A-M, pages-all	Can you please clarify if this project is set-aside for Small Business ?	Yes, this is procurement is set-aside for small business.
16. Section L, L.10(a)(B)	On sheet L-8 it states "15 days prior to the proposal due date, each offeror shall provide NASA CO with a list of contracts from whom the offeror has past performance information and send that list" to you. Please clarify that what is required is the list of three contacts to whom we sent the PPQ's to be completed and returned to you.	Yes, each offeror shall provide the NASA Ames Research Center Contracting Officer with a list of contracts from whom the offeror has past performance information and send that list via email to patricia.f.mendoza@nasa.gov .
17. Section L, L.8(b)(2)(i) Proposal Preparation-General Instructions	Since the 2013 EMR Rates have already been established, can we use 2011, 2012, and 2013 to provide the three-year average?	The Government requires three complete years, 2010, 2011, and 2012 with an average of all three.

Page L-8 First bullet - asks the contractor to “Describe any performance issues in the area of management and administration (address only the areas that apply).” And then identifies several items to be addressed. Are these items to be addressed specifically for each of the three projects that we will be submitting for experience, or are the questions directed towards our Companies overall approach to, and execution of, all projects in regards to project management, safety, quality control, schedule, submittals and etc.?</p>	<p>Yes, the Government requests you address for each of the three projects submitted.</p>
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
