2. Section I.11 NFS 1852.215-84 Ombudsman is replaced with NFS 1852.215-84 Ombudsman listed in the response below.

Response: I.11 NFS 1852.215-84 Ombudsman (NOV 2011)

(a) An ombudsman has been appointed to hear and facilitate the resolution of concerns from offerors, potential offerors, and contractors during the preaward and postaward phases of this acquisition. When requested, the ombudsman will maintain strict confidentiality as to the source of the concern. The existence of the ombudsman is not to diminish the authority of the contracting officer, the Source Evaluation Board, or the selection official. Further, the ombudsman does not participate in the evaluation of proposals, the source selection process, or the adjudication of formal contract disputes. 6. Part II, Past Performance, can projects greater than 90% complete be utilized as past performance projects or do they have to be completed?

Response: See L.11 Proposal Preparation Instructions for Multiple Award IDIQ General Construction Contract, Part II definition under **Recent** .

7. Our company is currently performing a contract on Redstone Arsenal and has an office at the contract site. Will this satisfy the Proximity requirement of Paragraph L.21?

Response: An established proximity to MSFC of 100 miles will be required to be considered.
