

Additional Proposal Instructions/Evaluation Criteria

The offeror is required to submit the following items for evaluation by the Government.

1. Technical Proposal
2. Warranties
3. Past Performance Proposal
4. Price Proposal

The following factors shall be used to evaluate offers:

1. Technical Merit

Offerors shall provide sufficient information and supporting documentation to allow the Government to determine whether the technical performance and specifications of the systems offered meets the Government's minimum requirements, as reflected in attachment 1, Requirements Document. Failure to address all requirements may negatively affect evaluation of an offerors' proposal. The offeror shall also describe acceptance test procedures proposed, applicable warranties, and maintenance agreements. The documentation supporting technical performance and specifications shall not exceed 20 pages.

2. Past Performance

The contractor shall provide and the Government will evaluate past performance references for three (3) projects that are similar in size and scope to this requirement and have occurred within the past three (3) years. Include a description of the work performed, as well as, names, phone numbers, contract numbers, contract value and email addresses for contact persons for each project referenced. Past performance will be evaluated for relevance to this requirement, quality of performance, timeliness and overall customer satisfaction. Past performance data shall not exceed 7 pages.

3. Price Proposal

Offerors shall submit a price that includes one TOTAL firm-fixed price that includes the following components:

- String Reel System
- RCS Ogive Pylon
- Antenna Positioner
- Rail Positioning System Components
- Rail System
- Warranty
