

The following answers are provided in response to questions received regarding RFP NNK13447748R. These answers shall not be construed as changing the RFP in any way.

38	Attch L.01	Govt Prov Hrs	Based on answer to Question #24 - the Government indicates that the difference in number of WYEs between Base Years 1 and 2 is due to 8 months versus 12 months. The total number of productive hours in Base Year 1 (assuming an 8 month period of performance and 1,832 productive hours in a full year) is 1,221 (1,832*(8/12)). The total number of hours in Base Years 1 and 2 in the Government pProvided Hours is 87,935 and 192,360, respectively. This indicates that the number of WYEs in Base Year 1 is 72 (87,935/1,221) and Base Year 2 is 105 (192,360/1,832). Will the Government clarify whether there is in fact an increase from 72 WYEs in Base Year 1 to 105 WYEs 8 months later in Base Year 2 or that Base Years 1 and 2 should have the same level of staffing?	As indicated in the answer to #24, information relevant to staffing requirements over the course of the contract may be found in the Bidder's Library. In addition, the increase referenced in the question also takes into account the difference in the base performance period (8 months in Base Period 1 and 12 months in Base Year 2). Note: the Core Effort Labor Hours (Attachment L.01) is expressed as hours not WYEs.

Therefore, Base Year Period 1 is in our fiscal year 2014. Today, we are in company fiscal year 2013. With this in mind, in the Basic Rates & Factors Templates, please confirm that the "Offeror Fiscal Year 1" is our company fiscal year 2014. (And "Offeror Fiscal Year Prior Year 1" will be our current provisional rates for 2013, "Offeror Fiscal Year Prior Year 2" will be our actual (unaudited) rates for 2012, and "Offeror Fiscal Year Prior Year 3" will be our actual (unaudited) rates for 2011).	Offerors are expected to comply with the instruction in Section L, Provision L.28, Instructions for Preparation of the Cost Proposal and Attachment L.04, Basic Rates and Factors Templates - Instructions Tab.
