#	Questions/Answers
1	<p>Q: Does NASA intend to coordinate any communication or collaboration between SAA recipients (e.g. CCSC SAA sharing sessions, capability exchange workshops, etc. with NASA and SAA participation) or is the intent to foster multiple one-on-one collaborations with NASA?</p> <p>A: NASA intends to collaborate directly with the recipient of a CCSC Agreement. NASA will use reasonable efforts to protect proprietary data. The data will be used only for U.S. Government purposes. However, NASA may engage in multi-party collaboration activities with permission of the SAA commercial partners.</p>
2	<p>Q: As part of the base support, will it be possible for partners to have discussions with NASA experts, or does this only include delivery of NASA data?</p> <p>A: Yes, discussions with NASA subject matter experts are intended to be provided as part of the base support at no cost to the commercial partner.</p>
3	<p>Q: What is the level of funding which NASA plans to spend on these SAAs?</p> <p>A: NASA has a limited amount of Government resources available to provide the base support negotiated in the Agreements. There is no specific amount allocated for each Agreement. There will be no exchange of funds between NASA and the selected partners.</p>
4	<p>Q: What if we need equipment which NASA might not have?</p> <p>A: NASA does not intend to provide Government Furnished Equipment under these Agreements. However, NASA will collaborate with its commercial partners to help identify alternate sources for the equipment they may need.</p>
5	<p>Q: Our project is long-term. Should we submit multiple phased proposals such as years 1-2, years 3-4, years 5-6, etc.?</p> <p>A: It would be best to submit the near term proposals. Requests for phased Government resources may be described in Appendix 2 of the proposal. There may be opportunities for additional competitions for future Space Act Agreements under this Announcement.</p>
