Continuation of Block 14 of the SF30, Amendment of Solicitation

The purpose of Amendment 02 is to post the questions and answers received for the RFP and to make the following revisions to the RFP:

1. Section L.24.4, *Volume II—Past Performance*, is hereby revised as follows:

- 1.1. The first sentence in paragraph (2) on page L-38 is revised to remove “magnitude.”

From:

(2) Offerors shall consider the relevancy, recency, and magnitude of the effort(s) as they relate specifically to this requirement.

To:

(2) Offerors shall consider the relevancy and recency of the effort(s) as they relate specifically to this requirement.

- 1.2. The bullet on page L-39 under paragraph (3) is revised

From:

If the Past Performance volume includes data on any parent or affiliated company that is not a proposed team member, then provide a narrative to address the specific resources (workforce, management, or other resources) of the parent or affiliated company, and the degree to which these resources will be provided or relied upon for contract performance, such that this parent or affiliated company will have meaningful involvement in contract performance.

To:

If the Past Performance volume includes data on any parent or affiliated company that is not a proposed team member, then provide a narrative to address the specific resources (workforce, management, or other resources) of the parent or affiliated company, and the degree to which these resources will be provided or relied upon for contract performance, such that this parent or affiliated company will have meaningful involvement throughout the contract period of performance.

- 1.3 Paragraph (6) on page L-40 is revised in the first sentence of the second paragraph

2. Attachment L-8, *Past Performance Relevancy Matrix*, is revised to remove “Parent/Affiliate” from the title of the legend.
3. Section L.24.2(b), Table L-2 is revised to increase the page limit for Volume IV, *Model Contract and Responsibility*, from 60 pages to 80 pages.
4. Attachment J-2, DRD MGMT-09, *Contract Phase-in Plan*, is revised to remove item number 6 from “Content” and mark it “Reserved.”
5. Section L.24.3, *Volume I—Mission Suitability*, and Section L.24.5, *Volume III—Cost/Price Proposal*, Technical Resources Summary Template (TRST) instructions are revised to clarify that the Volume I

narrative shall provide sufficient detail to understand both the resource basis and any deltas to the resource basis due to proposed efficiencies. These sections are revised as follows:

5.1. Section L.24.3, second paragraph on page L-26 is revised to add the following to the end of the paragraph, "The Offeror's proposal shall provide sufficient detail to allow the Government to understand and analyze both the resource basis and any deltas due to proposed efficiencies. The Offeror's proposal must present a clear and consistent description of what is being proposed across all sections.

5.2. Section L.24.5, the TRST instructions on page L-58 are revised at paragraphs (C) and (D)

From:

(C) In the column entitled "Resources Basis" Offerors are required to fill in their assumed staffing level prior to implementation of any changes, improvements, or efficiencies that result from the application of the Offeror's technical and management approach. The Offeror shall provide rationale, detailed narrative, and validation of their resource basis in Volume I.

(D) In the columns entitled "Proposed FTEs with Efficiencies" Offerors shall include all proposed labor resources after implementation of changes, improvements, or efficiencies resulting from its technical and management approach to satisfying the TO requirements. These proposed resources shall be an accumulation of all the resources justified in the Offeror's "Basis of Estimate (BOE)" paragraph in Volume I, Sub-factor 2, TA2 Specific Technical Understanding and Resources.

To:

(C) In the column entitled "Resources Basis" Offerors are required to fill in their assumed staffing level prior to implementation of any efficiencies that result from the application of the Offeror's technical and management approach. The Offeror shall provide rationale, detailed narrative, and validation of their resource basis in Volume I.

(D) If efficiencies are proposed, in the column entitled "Proposed FTEs with Efficiencies," the Offeror shall include all proposed labor resources after implementation of efficiencies resulting from its technical and management approach to satisfying the TO requirements. The Offeror shall also provide an integrated discussion including rationale, detailed narrative, and validation of their resources with the proposed efficiencies implemented as part of their responses in Volume 1. Sufficient detail to allow a thorough Government understanding and analysis of the proposed efficiency must be provided. The Offeror's proposal must present a clear and consistent description of what is being proposed across all sections.

If no efficiencies are proposed, the number of FTEs proposed in the "Resources Basis" column should be copied over to the "Proposed FTEs with Efficiencies" column.

6. Section L.24.3.3, SBU1, *Small Business Subcontracting*, is revised at paragraph (g) to remove the last sentence which reads, "Offerors shall modify the exhibit to show the proposed subcontracting goals for the basic contract requirement and each option separately."
7. Section L.24.5, paragraph 10, *Cognizant Federal Agency and Audit Office Template (CFAOT)*, is revised to remove the sentence that reads, "If an FPRA is not in effect, the Offeror shall provide a copy of the DCAA audit report of its FPRP (if available) or a copy of the audit report of its most recent cost proposal to NASA or other Government Agencies with the proposal submission."

8. Section L.24.6, the table in Part I, is revised to remove the requirement to complete the fill-in for clause B.5.1 in Section B.
9. The SF33 is revised at block 5 "Date Issued" to insert September 25, 2013, which was the date the IMOC II RFP was issued.

The document titled, "Questions and Answers 117-131" is included in this amendment. Also the SF33, Attachment J-2, Section L, and Attachment L-8, which incorporate the aforementioned changes, are hereby replaced in their entirety and are included in this amendment. Changes to the RFP are designated by vertical bar marks along the right side of the document.
