F.4 OPTION TO EXTEND PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE

The Government may require the contractor to continue to perform services under this contract beyond the above stated period of performance, through an option. The contracting officer may exercise this option by issuance of a unilateral contract modification 30 days or more before the end of the period of performance set forth in Clause F.3, Period of Performance. Should the option be exercised, the resultant contract will include all terms and conditions of the basic contract as it exists immediately prior to the exercise of the option, except for the following changes:

Option 2:

F.6 CONTRACT TRANSITION

(a) Phase-In: The services provided by this contract are vital to the Government's overall effort, and continuity must be maintained without disruption. The contractor is expected to meet full performance requirements from the start date of the base contract period. The Phase-In period shall not exceed 30 calendar days prior to the start date of the base contract period.

The total firm fixed price of Phase-In is identified in Section B, Clause B.8, Phase-In Value. Any costs incurred in excess of this amount shall be unallowable under this or any other Government contract.

(b) Phase-Out: The objectives of phase-out are to minimize impacts on continuity of operations, identify current issues, and overcome barriers to transition. The contractor shall ensure that all transition activities are identified, negotiated, and completed during the contract's transition into the period of performance of the successor contract.
