F.5 CONTRACT TRANSITION

(a) Phase-In: The services provided by this contract are vital to the Government's overall effort, and continuity must be maintained without disruption. The contractor is expected to meet full performance requirements from the start date of the base contract period. The Phase-In period shall not exceed 45 calendar days prior to the start date of the base contract period.

The total firm fixed price of Phase-In is identified in Clause **B.6, FIRM-FIXED PRICE PHASE- IN**. Any costs incurred in excess of this amount shall be unallowable under this or any other Government contract.

(b) Phase-Out: The objectives of phase-out are to minimize impacts on continuity of operations, identify current issues, and overcome barriers to transition. The contractor shall ensure that all transition activities are identified, negotiated, and completed during the contract's transition into the period of performance of the successor contract.
