

**Q12:** In order to complete the Subcontracting Arrangement Information section in Volume IV, Other Proposal Requirements, could JSC please define what the "primary and vital work" is on the CSFO contract?

**A12:** The "primary and vital requirements" of the CSFO contract are described in Section C - Statement of Work of the RFP. The Offeror's response to Section L.18.7 A. Subcontracting Arrangement Information clarifies the teaming arrangement between the prime contractor and any major subcontractors.

**Q13:** Page L-31 paragraph F (Draft Section L) How strict is the one page limit for introduction of company? Are more pages allowed as long as the volume is within the 30 page limit?

**A13:** Section 18.5 G. of the Final RFP (formerly Section 18.5 F. of the Draft RFP) clarifies the limitation. Offerors may include up to one (1) page of introductory material on the company, which is subject to the page limits. Please see the specific instructions for Proposal Arrangement, Page Limitations, etc., in Section L.18.2, Table L-2, in the CSFO Final RFP, available on the CSFO website.

**Q14:** Past Performance Volume - Are the safety data (OSHA 300 forms), consent letters, insurance carrier letters excluded from the page limit?

**A14:** Yes. All Safety and Health Data requested in Section L.18.5 I. (2) of the Final RFP (formerly Section L.18.5.H (2) of the Draft RFP), which includes OSHA 300 forms and insurance carrier letters do not count against the Past Performance Volume page limit. Similarly the consent letters requested in L.18.5 D. (12) do not count against the Past Performance page limit. Please see Section L.18.2 Table L-2 "Overview of Proposal Volumes, Page Limitations, Copies and Format" for what is included or excluded in the proposal page count.

**Q15:** Are the organizational charts that display the relationships and alignments between divisions, business units, groups, segments, or other organizations which are proposed to perform the effort (described in Section C 14) included in the page count?

**A15:** Section L.18.5.D (14) of the Final RFP (formerly Section L.18.5.C (14) of the Draft RFP) addressed the organizational charts that display the relationships and alignments between divisions, business units, groups, segments or other organizations which are proposed to perform the effort. Yes, this information is included in the page count. Please see Section L.18.2, Table L-2: "Overview of Proposal Volumes, Page Limitations, Copies and Format" for what is included or excluded in the proposal page count.

**Q16:** Is the incorporated matrix mentioned in Section C 14 included in the page count?

**A16:** Section L.18.5.D (14) of the Final RFP (formerly Section L.18.5.C (14) of the Draft RFP) addressed the incorporated matrix. This information is included in the page count. Please see Section L.18.2, Table L-2: "Overview of Proposal Volumes, Page Limitations, Copies and Format" for what is included or excluded in the proposal page count.

**Q17:** Is the proposal due date affected by the furlough?
