INDUSTRY QUESTIONS

16. Section L, Item 3, Other Information to be Provided – the section references (a), (b), and (d). Is there an item c?

NASA REPOSE: The section is mislabeled. The information identified as (d) should be (c). Amendment 1 will be posted to reflect this clarification.
17. Section L – Offer Volume & Technical Volume – In both the Offer Volume & Technical Volume there is a request for an SBA District Office Jurisdiction Documentation. Is it the intent to have this information repeated in both sections?

NASA RESPONSE: SBA District Office Jurisdiction documentation shall be included in both sections.
18. Section L.18, Past Performance – Is this section a narrative only? If not, can we use a “NAVAC/USACE Construction & Design Experience Data Sheet” that can be modified to incorporate all of the required information in section L and M of the RFP?

NASA RESPONSE: The format of the Offeror’s response is at the discretion of the Offeror, however, it must comply with limitations in section L.15 of the RFP related to font size, graphics, etc.
19. Section L.18, Past Performance – In the proposal content matrix on page 65 it states that the information from Offeror is limited to 25 pages. Pending the response to the previous question regarding the use of a NAVAC/USACE Construction & Design Experience Data Sheet (2-3 pages for 10 projects), this section also requests recent customer evaluations (PPQ & CCASS ratings range from 4-5 pages for 10 projects), and an OSHA Log for the past 3 years that will be 3 pages. All of these documents will exceed the page limitation. Please advise.

NASA RESPONSE: The 25 page count limitation, as stated in L.15 (b), only applies to the Information from the Offeror section of the Past Performance Volume. Recent Customer Evaluations are excluded from the page count limitation. Amendment 1 will be posted to reflect this clarification in section L.18.
20. Section L.18, Past Performance – To satisfy the average number of employees on contract per year and percent of turnover of personnel, is it acceptable to provide a company organizational chart that will capture all of our entire staff and organizational structure? If so, is it acceptable to use an 11x17 page that is tri-folded to make a single page?

NASA RESPONSE: The request for the average number of personnel on the contract per

year and percent turnover of personnel per year as stated in L.18 should be identified for each contract identified in the Offeror's past performance record. As stated in section L.15 (b) (2), foldouts count as an equivalent number of 8-1/2" x 11" pages.

21. How many contracts will be awarded?

NASA RESPONSE: As stated in L.7, the Government may elect to award a single delivery order contract or task order contract or to award multiple delivery order contracts or task order contracts for the same or similar supplies or services to two or more sources under this solicitation. NASA currently anticipates awarding two or more contracts.
