Question - 1.

Where is the information concerning the SACOM Preproposal Conference located?

Answer - 1.

The SACOM Preproposal Conference information is located in the RFP Section L.I-7 Preproposal / Pre-Bid Conference (NFS 1852.215-77).

Question - 2.

RFP Section L.I-7 Preproposal / Pre-Bid Conference (NFS 1852.215-77) states the following:

“In order to arrange access to SSC and MAF, offerors planning to attend shall notify Alec.E.Banks@nasa.gov **no later than 3:00 pm on Thursday, March 13, 2014**, with the company name, names of representatives, number of representatives and citizenship; offerors failing to do so may not be authorized to attend site visit.”

Can the date be extended?

Answer - 2.

The date to register for the site visit is extended until Monday, March 17, 2014 no later than 3:00 pm.

RFP Section L.I-7 Preproposal / Pre-Bid Conference (NFS 1852.215-77) is hereby changed to read:

“In order to arrange access to SSC and MAF, offerors planning to attend shall notify Alec.E.Banks@nasa.gov **no later than 3:00 pm on Monday, March 17, 2014**, with the company name, names of representatives, number of representatives and citizenship; offerors failing to do so may not be authorized to attend site visit.”

Question - 3.

L.I-7(a) states, “Offerors are limited to 2 individuals per company.” Would it be possible to have 2 people attend the Pre-Proposal Briefing on March 19th and 2 different people attend the Site Visits? It is important for business personnel to attend the Pre-Proposal Briefing and for technical personnel to attend the site visit. Allowing separate personnel to attend will allow offerors to maximize their knowledge about the contract requirements.

Answer - 3.

You can substitute attendees as long as there are only 2 attendees per day (see example below).

March 19	Employee A and Employee B
March 20	Employee A and Employee C
March 21	Employee A and Employee C

Question - 4.

Will photos be permitted during the Preproposal Conference and Site Visits?

Answer - 4.

Photographing or videoing will not be allowed during the Preproposal Conference or Site Visits.
