

SYNOPSIS FOR THE
SYNERGY-ACHIEVING CONSOLIDATED OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE
(SACOM) CONTRACT
AT THE NATIONAL AERONAUTICS AND SPACE ADMINISTRATION
JOHN C. STENNIS SPACE CENTER AND MARSHALL SPACE FLIGHT CENTER'S
MICHLOUD ASSEMBLY FACILITY (MAF)

The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) Stennis Space Center (SSC) Office of Procurement intends to issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) to perform facility operations and maintenance of institutional and technical facilities and manufacturing and test support services at John C. Stennis Space Center (SSC), Mississippi, and Marshall Space Flight Center's (MSFC) Michoud Assembly Facility (MAF), Louisiana.

The Contractor shall manage and be responsible for providing all services, equipment and supplies, except as provided as Government Property, to implement the SACOM Performance Work Statement (PWS).

The Government contemplates award of a single Hybrid Cost-Plus-Incentive-Fee (CPIF), Firm-Fixed-Price (FFP), Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ), with Award Term Options performance-based contract resulting from this solicitation.

The North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code for this procurement is 561210, Facilities Support Services, with a size standard of \$35.5M.

A draft RFP was released on March 4, 2014, which allowed industry until March 31, 2014, to comment or ask questions concerning any aspect of the solicitation. As a result of the comments received, the RFP has been revised and should be formally released to industry on or about May 19, 2014, with proposals due on or about July 11, 2014.

The solicitation (RFP) and any related documents will only be issued electronically. They will be available over the Internet. These documents will reside on a World-Wide Web (WWW) server, which may be accessed using a WWW browser application.
