The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) is soliciting offers from interested firms to perform select Agency business and administrative services at the NASA Shared Services Center (NSSC) located on Stennis Space Center (SSC), MS. The requirements call for non-personal services in the areas of Financial Management, Human Resources, Procurement, Information Technology and Agency Business Services. The goal of this procurement is to conduct a fair, full and open competition that results in an award to a Service Provider that will enhance the NSSC's ability to meet its mission. A DRAFT RFP was released on May 2, 2014. Potential Offerors are cautioned to read/review the FINAL RFP and all attachments carefully. An Industry day event was held May 15, 2014. Changes to the terms and/or conditions of the FINAL RFP will be accomplished by an amendment to this solicitation. It is the responsibility of potential Offerors to monitor the Government Point of Entry, FedBizOpps (www.fbo.gov) and/or the NASA Acquisition Internet Service (NAIS) for the release of additional information pertaining to this solicitation.
