1.6. ECONOMIC PRICE ADJUSTMENT

An Economic Price Adjustment (EPA) will be used to semiannually adjust the price of each CLIN from the base period price. Contract price adjustments for each subsequent six-month period following the base period will be updated by contract modification at least one month prior to the start of the period.

The base price will be adjusted, whether up or down, in accordance with the composite index described herein. The composite index is formulated using three special indices with weights applied to the special indices.

- (a) Special Indices. The three special indices that contribute to the composite index are the natural gas index, power index and fuel index. These special indices shall be derived from the following index series:
  - (1) Natural Gas index: The Producer Price Index for Natural Gas, series WPU0531, as published by the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics shall be referred to as the Natural Gas index.
  - (2) Power index: The Producer Price Index for Electrical Power Distribution, Industrial Electric Power, series PCU22112222112243, as published by the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics shall be referred to as the Power index.
  - (3) Fuel index: The Producer Price Index for Petroleum Refineries, Diesel Fuel, series PCU324110324110AY2 as published by the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, shall be referred to as the fuel index.
