Q1. *Is there a list of existing Technology Transfer efforts in work which are not yet on the website?*

A1. No there is no list, but not all Tech Transfer efforts are listed on the website.

Q2. *Does GRC have a network of SMEs that are regularly used?*

A2. Yes, internally.

Q3. *How much travel from the contractor site to GRC has been required in the past, to participate in meetings and events?*

A3. A plug number is provided as an anticipated dollar amount to cover approximately 6 trips per year to GRC and other venues. If the amount of cost/trips change they will be negotiated at the time a task is issued.

Q4. *Are some of the research or consultant services procured as material dollars?*

A4. No

Q5. *Are there other materials that need to be budgeted for?*

A5. A plug number is provided as an anticipated dollar amount to cover materials. If the requirements change they will be negotiated at the time a task is issued.

Q6. *How does the Commercialization Analysis and Review of Technology (CART) process work and is the contractor involved in the process?*

A6. The contractor is involved in the review of NTRs received in a given month, participates in the discussions and provides input on the next steps.

Q7. *How many GRC civil servants are currently in the TTO and what are their roles?*

A7. 7 civil servants. (1 Manager, 1 SBIR lead, 1 SBIR Technology Infusion Engineer, 1 Tech Transfer Engineer, 1 Program Specialist, 1 Space Act Agreement Manager, 1 Space Act Agreement/Licensing Administrator.)

Q8. *Are any of the TTO support services provided indirect on the current contract?*

A8. No

Q9. *Is the workload expected to grow?*

A9. Potentially, but cannot be guaranteed.
