SOURCE SELECTION STATEMENT
Electrical Trade Services Blanket Purchase Agreement
Request for Proposal NNC14ZCH009R

Background

This procurement is to establish a Blanket Purchase Agreement (BPA) under which the contractor shall provide all supervision, personnel, material, equipment, and supplies necessary to successfully perform electrical trade services throughout NASA Glenn Research Center (GRC). To accomplish this effort, the Government will award a single BPA for a time period of two years.

A Request for Quote (RFQ) was issued June 30, 2014, through the NASA Acquisition Internet Service (NAIS). One proposal was received by the due date of July 31, 2014, from the R.J. Runge Company.

Evaluation Results

The proposal was evaluated in accordance with Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) 12.6 - Streamlined Procedures for Evaluation and Solicitation for Commercial Items. The proposal was evaluated considering three factors: Technical Capability, Price, and Relevant Experience and Past Performance. All three Factors were considered equal in importance. The Technical Capability Factor contained three sub areas which were considered equal in importance.

R.J. Runge Company

Overall, Technical Capability was rated "Above Average". The proposal received "Outstanding" to "Above Average" ratings in the three sub areas. The response in the first two sub areas (detailed description to perform the work and project management) were considered to be strengths and were rated "above average". The response in the third sub area (key personnel) was of particular note. All submitted key management, were college educated, certified and very experienced. This was considered a significant strength and the sub area was rated "outstanding."

Overall, Past Performance was rated "Outstanding". The contractor was deemed to have highly relevant work experience. Runge currently has the NASA Glenn contract for this work. The submitted past performance questionnaires rated the company "outstanding". NASA personnel have high marks and praise for the Company work efforts.

In the Pricing area, information was considered complete. The proposal included fully-burdened pricing for the labor categories considered necessary to perform the effort. The proposal also included the costs for equipment typically required for these types of projects. The pricing was also in line with prior contracts for similar services.

Decision

I have reviewed the evaluation findings and understand the process used to evaluate the proposal.

In the area of Technical Capability, I find Runge to be rated "Above Average". In two of the sub areas, Runge was rated "above average". In the third sub area, Runge was rated "outstanding" by proposing highly qualified key personnel who have considerable experience at GRC. I consider the response in Technical Capability to be fully responsive to the RFP and a strong indicator of their capability to successfully perform the work effort.

In the area of Relevant Experience and Past Performance, I note that Runge had highly relevant work experience at GRC performing on the current contract effort. I find that Runge was rated "outstanding" in two submitted Past Performance Questionnaires and received a strong endorsement from NASA personnel. As the incumbent contractor successfully performing on the current work activity, I consider this to be a strong indicator of successful performance on the anticipated contract effort.

In the area of Price, I note that Runge's information was considered complete and the proposed rates were in line with similar services in prior years. The prices were also in line with the last Government Cost Estimate.

Based on the above, I find the Runge proposal to be fully responsive to the solicitation and Runge fully capable of performing the work effort.

I hereby select the R.J. Runge Company to perform the requirements as outlined in the solicitation NNC14ZCH009R.
