Block 14 Description of Amendment/Modification (continued):

The purpose of Amendment 01 is to post questions and answers received for the RFP and to make the following revisions to the RFP.

The document titled, "Human Health and Performance Contract (HHPC) Final RFP Questions and Answers" is included in this Amendment. Also Attachment L-4 "GRE Revision," Attachment L-7 "IDIQ Templates," and Attachment L-10, "Performance Information Matrix," which incorporate the changes described below are hereby replaced in their entirety and are included as attachments to this Amendment.

1. Section L.22.4 (a) "Volume II-Past Performance," is hereby revised as follows:

From:

(a) Provide information from organizations and companies for which your company has previously performed work, in order for the Government to obtain appraisals of past performance. Offerors, including joint ventures, major subcontractors (subcontracts with an estimated annual value greater than \$5M) shall each provide information on up to five past contracts (subject to the page limitation constraints). References with Government contracts are preferred, but not required.

To:

(a) Provide information from organizations and companies for which your company has previously performed work, in order for the Government to obtain appraisals of past performance. Offerors, including joint ventures, major subcontractors (subcontracts with an estimated annual value greater than \$5M) *and the proposed program manager* shall each provide information on up to five past contracts (subject to the page limitation constraints). References with Government contracts are preferred, but not required.

2. The second paragraph of Section M.6 "Past Performance Factor," is hereby revised as follows:

From:

Past Performance indicates how well an Offeror performed on earlier work and can be a significant indicator of how well it can be expected to perform the work at hand. The Offeror's past performance (contract performance and quality performance), including recent experience, will be evaluated by the SEB. The Government will use past performance information from proposal data required by provision L.22.4, Volume II – Past Performance, information obtained by the SEB team based on communications with listed references, as well as data independently obtained from other government and commercial sources, such as the NASA Past Performance Database and similar systems of other governmental departments and agencies, Defense Contract Management Agency (DCMA) channels, interviews with client program managers and contracting officers, and other sources known to the Government, including commercial sources. Offerors are to note that, in conducting this assessment, the Government reserves the right to use both data provided by the Offeror and data obtained from other sources. The Government will consider the number and severity of problems, the effectiveness of corrective actions taken and the overall record of past performance. It shall also consider the Offeror's record for adherence to contract schedules and cost control.

To:

Past Performance indicates how well an Offeror performed on earlier work and can be a significant indicator of how well it can be expected to perform the work at hand. The Offeror's past performance (contract performance and quality performance), including recent experience, will be evaluated by the SEB. *The past performance of the proposed Program Manager will also be evaluated.* The Government

will use past performance information from proposal data required by provision L.22.4, Volume II – Past Performance, information obtained by the SEB team based on communications with listed references, as well as data independently obtained from other government and commercial sources, such as the NASA Past Performance Database and similar systems of other governmental departments and agencies, Defense Contract Management Agency (DCMA) channels, interviews with client program managers and contracting officers, and other sources known to the Government, including commercial sources. Offerors are to note that, in conducting this assessment, the Government reserves the right to use both data provided by the Offeror and data obtained from other sources. The Government will consider the number and severity of problems, the effectiveness of corrective actions taken and the overall record of past performance. It shall also consider the Offeror’s record for adherence to contract schedules and cost control.

3. Attachment L-4 “Government Resource Estimate” has been modified to correct a discrepancy in the Work Year Equivalent estimates provided in “Table 3 - Cumulative Labor WYE’s by Skill Mix and Non-Labor Resources GRE (Represents the entire SOW in Contract Year 1).”
4. Attachment L-7 “IDIQ Templates” has been modified to ensure consistency between the standard labor categories listed in Attachment L-7, Section B, and Attachment L-1.
5. Attachment L-10 “Past Performance Information Matrix” has been modified to replace verbiage, which stated that “The SEB fills in the WBS numbers for their effort” with “The Offeror fills in the SOW numbers for their effort, corresponding to the sections of the HHPC SOW for which the cited contract Past Performance demonstrates relevancy.”

In addition, the instructions contained within the document have also been revised to align with the revised verbiage described above. Also, a row entitled “Program Manager” has been added to Attachment L-10 to allow Offerors to cite relevant contract Past Performance for the “Program Manager.”
