- Q8) RFP Section G.10, please confirm that the successful offeror will not be required to track Government Property that is provided to the Fellows; i.e. the successful offeror will only be required to track Government Property used by employees of the offeror in support of the NPP program.
- A8) Any Government property provided to the Fellows will be tracked at each Center by the Center's NPP Civil Servant Representative. In addition, there will be no Government property provided to the successful offeror's offsite personnel.
- Q9) RFP Section L.7 (2), please clarify the requirement to submit an additional, separately labelled Cost Proposal for DCAA. Does this apply to all offerors including those under DCAA authority?
- A9) Yes, this applies to all offerors.
- Q10) Page 25 of the RFP, Clause H.9 -- Advance Agreement Between the Parties: Requirement to Provide Contract Historical Data (GSFC 52.242-91) (Aug 2013). The contractor is concerned with NASA's potential use of the requested information, and public release of Contractor proprietary and competition sensitive data, and how will the Government insure that company specific proprietary information is not released in follow-on solicitations?
- A10) After further review of the clause and the unique requirements of this contract, the Government has decided to amend the solicitation to remove the clause and associated attachment. See Amendment 2.
- Q11) Due to the severe weather conditions in the Washington, D.C. metro area these recent weeks, impacting our staff's ability to effectively work on the NASA Postdoc Program Proposal, USRA requests a short delay of one week, for the due date of the NPP proposal submittal to NASA, from Friday, February 27th to Friday, March 6th.
- A11) The proposal due date **will not** be extended. Proposals are due February 27, 2015 by 2:00pm.
