This notice is issued by Inu Teq, LLC to post a Statement of Work (SOW) via the internet, and solicit responses from interested parties which is issued as a RFI. This document is for information and planning purposes and to allow industry the opportunity to verify reasonableness and feasibility of the requirement, as well as promote competition. Prospective offerors are invited to submit written comments or questions to: afrc-rfess-procurement@mail.nasa.gov no later than 12:00 p.m. PST on March 16, 2015. When responding, reference Solicitation Number INU-15-002. Responses to the questions will be posted on this site no later than 5:00 p.m. PST on March 23, 2015. All responses to the RFI must be emailed to afrc-rfess-procurement@mail.nasa.gov by 5:00 p.m. PST on March 31, 2015.

Inu Teq, LLC is requesting information for SharePoint Project Support. Support is required to meet development needs in the quickly growing Armstrong Flight Research Center (AFRC) Share Point environment.

The demand for development by Armstrong's current SharePoint development staff is great which has resulted in a backlog of projects. Armstrong seeks the ability to add SharePoint developers as needed to meet high development demands in the SharePoint arena.

In order to send information, one copy and one original must be provided of the following:

- Cost Proposal – Hourly rate for the SharePoint Developer will be provided in the bid submitted in the response to the RFI. Any price breaks that occur when hours are purchased in certain blocks of time must also be included in the response.
- Past Performance Proposal – Interested parties must submit references and examples of past performance in similar contract arrangements. Inu-Teq reserves the right to contact references provided to verify quality of work.
