

RFP NNK15545450R – LETF Testing Questions

1. Will NASA need two (2) LH2 tankers on site at the same time, or will one (1) LH2 tanker be acceptable, performing a drop and swap when product is needed?

In accordance with RFP NNK15545450R, Section 3.0, Statement of Work, NASA may require up to two trailers at one time.

2. NASA KSC has a current LH2 supplier, couldn't NASA have them fulfill the requirement; adding this as a new fill point?

The current LH2 contract does not include the requirement for the LETF testing.

3. On page 11, CLIN 001, the BEQ is 16, is this 16 total if NASA were to exercise the option period, or would it then be 32 total?

The BEQ of 16 is the total estimate, including both the base and option period.

4. Page 11, the last sentence, this would suggest NASA is looking for our Cost Stack for each CLIN, if in fact we elect to bid, correct?

In accordance with RFP NNK15545450R, Section 5.0, Proposal Instructions, the contractor shall provide fully burdened rates for CLIN 001, CLIN 002 and CLIN 003. Therefore, these rates shall include all labor, materials, fringe, G&A, profit, and any other associated costs.

5. Does NASA have adapters to convert a HQK bayonet fitting to an Air Force fitting?

Yes, NASA has two (2) adapters, with a 2" male Linde bayonet fitting to a 2" Air Force female bayonet fittings.

6. How many testing periods will be done, and what is the frequency?

Currently there are nine (9) test periods planned with seven (7) in the base period and (2) in the option period. Current planning shows up to two test periods in a single month, with a week or so in between each test. Schedule and test frequency is subject to change.

7. What is the estimated duration from requested delivery time to trailer release?

It is estimated that the trailer(s) would be held for up to two days following delivery. Testing is estimated to last one or two days for each test period; however, additional days may be required due to unforeseen circumstances (operational issues, weather, etc.)

8. Is there an established minimum notice for deliveries and pickups?

The contractor will be given at least seven (7) days' notice of initial delivery orders.

9. Is there any required security clearance, documentation or training the driver must have to make a delivery?

10. Is there an ability to adjust price based on formulas (diesel fuel cost, henry hub, etc.)?

No, in accordance with RFP NNK15545450R, Section 5.0, Proposal Instructions, the contractor shall provide fully burdened rates for CLIN 001, CLIN 002 and CLIN 003.
