**KSC Center Export Administrator (CEA)**  
**ITAR Expectations for NASA Off-Site Fabricators, Manufacturers, and Vendors**

**A. General Requirements**

As a potential supplier or subcontractor to Kennedy Space Center (KSC) vendors shall acknowledge that information exchanged between KSC and the vendor may include the use of, or access to, Export Controlled Technical Data (as defined below).

The Vendor will comply with the following export control requirements:

1. The Vendor shall be incorporated, or registered to do business, in the U.S.
2. The Vendor representative(s) dealing directly with NASA shall be a U.S. citizen or permanent U.S. resident.
3. Vendor employees who will have access to Export Controlled Technical Data or Defense Articles shall be advised of their obligations regarding compliance with export control laws and regulations.
4. The Vendor shall comply with all applicable U.S. Government export control laws and regulations before:
  - a. Disclosing Export Controlled Technical Data or Defense Articles to any person who is not a U.S. citizen or permanent resident;
  - b. Providing any person who is not a U.S. citizen or permanent resident with access to Export Controlled Technical Data or Defense Articles; or
  - c. Assigning any person who is not a U.S. citizen or permanent resident to perform work which requires access to Export Controlled Technical Data or Defense Articles.
5. The Vendor shall agree to ensure that the export requirements outlined in this document are also conveyed to all sub-tier suppliers that may have access to Export Controlled Technical Data or Defense Articles.
6. The vendor shall immediately notify the NASA Contracting Officer when potential violation occur at the Vendor's facility or at a sub-tiered supplier.
7. The Vendor shall immediately notify the NASA Contracting Officer if the Vendor is acquired by a foreign entity (government or company) or if the Vendor is owned or controlled (directly or indirectly) by a foreign entity.

**B. Export Control Markings**

The Vendor agrees to mark any Export Controlled Technical Data or Defense Articles which need to be protected under ITAR (as defined below) or EAR (as defined below) with one or both of the following export control statements:

ITAR Statement

**WARNING** - This document contains technical data, export of which is restricted by the International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR). Disclosure to foreign persons without prior U.S. Government

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approval is prohibited. Violations of these export laws and regulations are subject to severe civil and criminal penalties.

**C. ITAR Required Registration (Not required by NASA Procurement for this procurement)**

Section 122.1(a) of the ITAR requires that any person who engages in the United States in the business of either manufacturing or exporting Defense Articles or furnishing Defense Services must register with the DDTC
